# The Process

- Send in your entry form with your **\$50 entry fee**.
- Receive your entry confirmation from Beef + Lamb New Zealand.
- Send your stock (mob size 10-30) to a participating plant for processing in the week commencing **Monday 8 February 2010**. (Farmers will be paid as per schedule for all lambs supplied).
- Each entrant will have a lamb randomly chosen from their mob and two legs removed for analysis at Carne Technologies in Cambridge.
- Finalists will be chosen based on an initial evaluation of yield and tenderness.
- At the final taste-off, a panel of leading chefs and celebrities will judge the 16 finalist lamb cuts on taste, tenderness, aroma, juiciness and texture.
- Judging and prizegiving will take place at the Upper Clutha A & P Show in Wanaka on **Friday 12 March, 2010**.
- Cooking demonstrations will be undertaken on Saturday 13 March, 2010.

# The Challenge

The 2010 New Zealand Golden Lamb Awards is open to all New Zealand sheep farmers.

The competition will choose four finalists from four classes:

## **Class 1: Best of Breed DUAL PURPOSE**

- The terminal breed influence in the lamb must be no more than 25%.
- The sire and dam breed must be dual purpose breeds in the form of purebreds, composites or crossbreds.

## **Class 2: Best of Breed DUAL PURPOSE X TERMINAL**

- The terminal breed influence in the lamb must be no more than 50%.
- The dam must be a dual purpose breed either in the form of a purebred, composite or cross bred and the sire a terminal breed either in the form of a purebred, composite or crossbred.

## **Class 3: Best of Breed COMPOSITE / CROSSBREED X TERMINAL**

- The terminal breed influence in the lamb must be no more than 75%.
- The dam must be either a crossbred or a composite and can contain either dual purpose or terminal breeds. The sire must be a terminal or a predominantly terminal breed.

## **Class 4: Best of Breed TERMINAL**

- The terminal breed influence in the lamb must be greater than 75%.
- Both the dam and sire must be either terminal or predominantly terminal breeds.

# Conditions of Entry

- One entry per farm.
- Entry form must be returned to Beef + Lamb New Zealand by Friday 29 January, 2010 at 5pm.
- Stock to be at nominated plant for processing in the week commencing Monday 8 February, 2010.
- Breeds to be entered into a class as defined by the New Zealand Flock Book.
- Carcass weight range: 15 - 21kg.
- Mob size: 10 - 30.
- Lambs must be grade Y or P. Lambs grades T, F or Y devoid of fat will not be eligible.
- 75% of the mob must meet weight and grade criteria to be eligible as a finalist.
- Lambs must be weaned a minimum of 2 weeks from the ewe.
- Stud breeders eligible to enter, but can only enter commercial stock.
- All product must be of Quality Mark standard.
